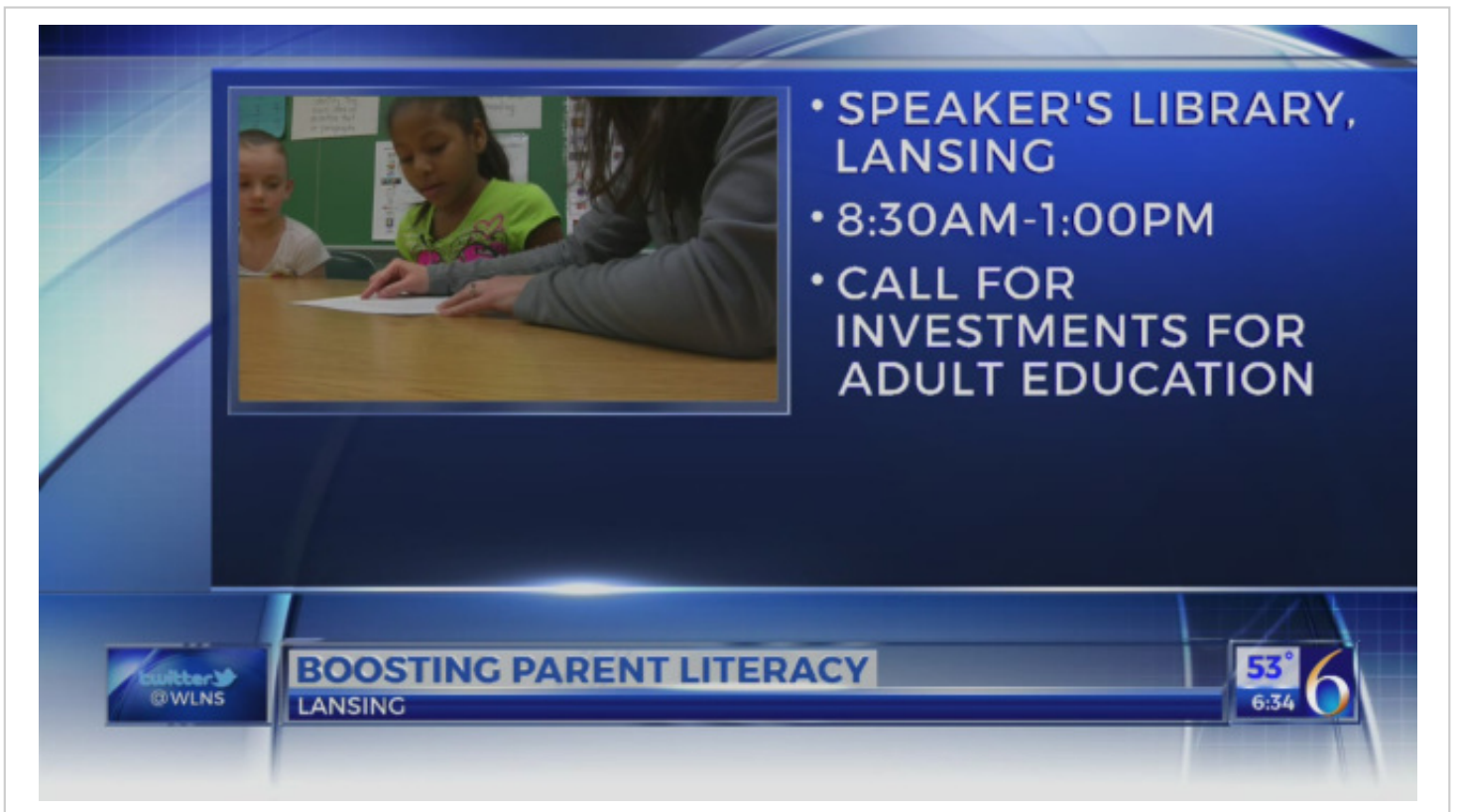




Young parents call for adult education investments

LANSING, MI (WLNS) – Two state policy groups say many young adults have turned the page on their own literacy skills.

They also say it's having a direct and negative impact on their children.

A forum Wednesday aims to help change this.

According to state education officials 42,000 people in Michigan between the ages of 18-34 have less than a 9th grade education.

Policy groups focused on children and education say the lack has a lasting impact on their kids too.

At Wednesday's forum young parents will address state lawmakers to call for more investments towards adult education.
