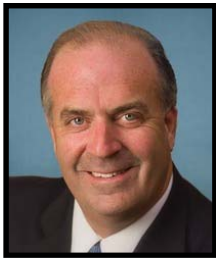

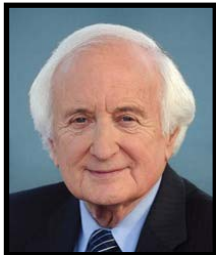

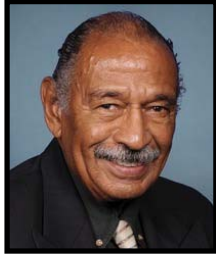
Representative Debbie Dingell (Democrat), 12th District: Detroit's in northern suburbs, including the counties of Washtenaw and Wayne County.
