Elected: Slotkin is serving her second two-year term in Congress after being elected in November 2018. Her current term expires on Jan. 3, 2023.

Committee Appointments: Elissa Slotkin serves on the House Armed Services Committee, and serves on its Subcommittees on Cyber, Innovative Technologies, and Information Systems and on Readiness. She also served on the House Committee on Homeland Security, serving as the Chairwoman of its Subcommittee on Intelligence and Counterterrorism and serving on its Subcommittee on Cybersecurity, Infrastructure Protection and Innovation.

Experience in Congress: Rep. Slotkin has supported enacted legislation to extend for family farmers, and expand the Paycheck Protection Program. Slotkin is also a new member of the bi-partisan Problem Solvers Caucus.

Political experience: Rep. Slotkin did not previously hold public office before entering Congress in 2019.

Biography: Slotkin worked for the Central Intelligence Agency as a Middle East analyst following the September 11th attacks. Slotkin worked with US military in Iraq three times as a militia expert, and served in the Office of the Director of National Intelligence under the Bush and Obama administrations. She served as Acting Assistant Secretary of Defense for International Affairs from 2014 to 2017 in the Obama Administration. Rep. Slotkin's family owns a farm in Holly.
