**Elected:** Stevens is serving her second two-year term in Congress after being elected in November 2018. Her current term expires on Jan. 3, 2023.

**Committee Appointments**: Stevens serves on the House Education and Labor Committee, and its Subcommittee on Health, Employment, Labor and Pensions, and its Subcommittee on Workforce Protections. Stevens also serves on the Science, Space and Technology, serving as chair of the Subcommittee on Research and Technology.

**Caucus Leadership:** She is co-chair of the Future of Work Task Force and vice chair of the American Sikh Congressional Caucus. She also served on the Black Maternal Health Caucus, Robotics Caucus, and over a dozen other caucuses.

**Experience in Congress**: Stevens has sponsored enacted legislation including research for suicide prevention.

Political experience: Stevens did not previously hold public office before entering Congress in 2019.

**Biography:** Stevens most recently worked for the Digital Manufacturing and Design Innovation Institute in Chicago. Prior to that, she was involved in setting up the Office of Recovery for Automotive Communities and Workers, and the White House Office of Manufacturing Policy; she also served as a policy advisor in its Economic Development Administration. Stevens served as chief of staff of the Presidential Task Force on the Auto Industry in the Obama administration. She studied at American University. She is a married mother of one.
