Elected: McClain is serving her first term in Congress after being elected in November 2020. Her current two-year term expires on Jan. 3, 2023.

The company has over 700 employees and over \$7 billion in assets. She is a member of the Hantz Foundation which helps underserved communities in Detroit's east-side neighborhood. McClain is the founder and president of North End Support Team in Macomb County which helps residents suffering from drug abuse and addiction. She is a married mother of four children.
